**Dr. Larry Brasher will exhibit his rare silver-hilted Revolutionary sword, and tell the saga of his search for its origin, which sheds light on local Revolutionary war time issues, including the interaction of patriots and loyalists in the counties of Morris and Hunterdon.**

**Descended from the Peter and Ann Hance Watters family who farmed 87 acres in Succasunna from 1848 to 1918, which included a home dating to 1729 that is still a residence, Dr. Brasher will also exhibit items from his extensive collection of Succasunna artifacts and Church memorabilia.**
